**\* Pennsylvania** (Ranking: 1) Pennsylvania's efforts to protect women from the negative consequences of abortion have been ground-breaking. Pennsylvania has led the way for other states by enacting such measures as informed consent, parental consent, and state funding of abortion alternatives.

**\* West Virginia** (Ranking: 32) Over the past several years, West Virginia has made significant strides toward protecting women and the unborn, enacting an informed consent law for abortion and protections for unborn victims of violence. However, West Virginia still lacks important protections for women considering abortion and in the area of biotechnologies.

**\* Maryland** (Ranking: 40) Maryland provides virtually no protection for women and minors seeking abortion. It does not have an informed consent law or abortion clinic regulations, and its parental notice law contains a loophole that eviscerates the protection this requirement typically provides. The state also allows and funds destructive embryo research.
